

SPGA Rules - Pagoda Golf Course

Sunday, April 18, 2021

Tee Boxes:

Champ Flight (0.0 to 14.5 handicap) Blue Tees
A Flight (14.6 to 36.0 handicap) Blue/White combo tees.. See scorecard
Ladies Green Tees

- For today's tourney we are playing the ball down. **NO LIFT CLEAN AND PLACE**
- If your ball comes to rest in a bunker filled with water, you are allowed to take the nearest point of relief, while still staying in the bunker.
- Because there are no rakes in the bunkers you are allowed to mark, lift, clean, and rake with your foot and place the ball within one scorecard length of your original spot.
- Assign one person in each group to keep score for the group on your Golf Genius app. Another one person keeps one written score card for the group. Keep your own scorecard as a back-up.
- Everyone is responsible for reviewing their own score after the round. **ONLY ONE SIGNATURE is required per scorecard.**
- Pass the one official scorecard to the SPGA group behind you.
- All scorecards eventually are given to Jim Zalusky.
- All local rules apply as noted on the scorecard
- If you have an (h) designation behind your name on the Golf Genius app, it is because you have not entered at least 5 scores for handicap purposes since Jan 1, 2020 Therefore, for the time being you are competing in the Champ Flight and only your gross scores will count towards OOM points. Once you have entered 5 scores into BCGA you can compete in the correct division for your handicap and earn either Gross or Net OOM points.
- The Pagoda concession hut after the 9th hole will be open.
- Call the golf course to reserve golf carts at least a day before.
- The putting green & chipping practice areas are open. There are 2 practice nets.

- As always **PLAY READY GOLF** on every hole on every shot. If it's safe to hit, hit. Competitive rounds should not be longer than 4 hours, 30 mins. Keep up to the group ahead of you. Quick play is everyone's responsibility.
- There will NOT be any KP, Long Drive or Straightest Drive contests nor 50/50 draws for junior golf for this round.
- Refer to the www.spgagolf.com web site for OOM points. Like last season, there are two divisions: Champ Flight (0.0 to 14.5) and A Flight (14.5+). Gross and Net points will be awarded for positions 1 thru 10
- Next tournament on Saturday, April 25, 2021 at Ledgeview Golf Course in Abbotsford with tee times beginning at 10:30 AM

Covid-19 Rules

- Pagoda asks that you wear a mask around the pro shop and that you do not show up until 30 mins prior to your tee time. If you do, please stay in your car.
- Due to Covid-19 we MUST all practice social distancing, which means staying away from your playing partners, by at least 6 feet or 2 meters. This has been mandated by BC Health and Federal Health Authorities.
- Do not shake hands or give high fives. Anyone seen doing so, may be subject to removal by the on-course Marshals.
- Do not touch the flagstick. Leave it in the hole. Try to avoid touching your face. If you can, bring hand sanitizer with you for the day.
- Do not congregate in groups larger than 4 people before, during or after the round, even in the parking lot.
- If you have been sick (or have been in close contact with anyone who has) or are showing any symptoms of Covid-19 such as fever, dry cough, general lethargy, DO NOT ATTEND. Stay at home.
- If you have any underlying health conditions such as: lung disease, chronic kidney or liver disease, diabetes, moderate to severe asthma, severe obesity, compromised immune systems or heart conditions, DO NOT ATTEND. Stay at home
- If you have travelled outside of the county in the last 14 days. DO NOT ATTEND. Stay at home. As ruled by the Federal Government of Canada.
